1. Nomination

3. Scholarship

> JASSO scholarship

Please note that not all International Division students are eligible for JASSO Scholarship. The head office of JASSO informs us of the number of JASSO Scholarship recipients available for the International Division, usually in the end of February every year. The result of decision by JASSO and the nomination steps will be sent to all our partner institutions by the beginning of March. Then, around the end of June, we will inform the official approval of your student as the JASSO scholarship recipient.

We will inform the prospective exchange students about the updated information and requirements for JASSO scholarship later.

4. Summer Intensive Japanese Language and Culture Program

*Additional Fee Required

To provide international students with more chances to experience our language and culture, we started this program in 2004, and we have received much praise from participants. It is also a good opportunity for students who are willing to study Japanese for a short period.

The program dates next year is from <u>July 1, 2019 – August 1, 2019.</u> The program is full of field work, such as a visit to local shrine, temples, and a two-day trip in/around Kyushu area. It enables students to have more interests in studying Japanese and learning Japanese culture. This program is open for both exchange and self-financed international students with additional program fee of 160,000 JPY including tuition and housing fee. <u>To attend this program</u>, students should arrive at Seinan on June 29 or 30 before the International Division starts in August.

5. Important Notice for Prospective Students: Visa Status

To maintain students' visa status, we require all international students to follow the responsibilities as below. Failure to do so can result in his/her removal from college and the country.

- 1) Take "Japanese" and "Japanese Orthography and Reading Skills" courses, which are mandatory in the International Division. "Japanese Orthography and Reading Skills" could be an elective if a student is in "Advanced Japanese" course.
- 2) Maintain at least 14 credits in the International Division
- 3) Regular and punctual attendance is required in all courses. If a student is absent from three or more classes at each course with unexcused reasons, he/she may fail the course immediately.
