


LEARN FRENCH in Angers, in the Loire Valley

CIDEF is an exam centre for certifications and university diplomas, and prepares for the DELF (Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue Française) and DALF (Diplôme Approfondi de Langue Française).

LANGUE FRANÇAISE ET CULTURES FRANCOPHONES

Entry requirements: French baccalauréat or equivalent

Taught courses offered: A1 (beginner) to C1 (advanced)

Minimum period of study: three months

Contact hours: 21 per week

✓ Assessment: continuous assessment and final exam

Courses

Classes are taught in groups according to level from A1 to C1 (see table on opposite page). Depending on academic results, a university diploma may be awarded at the end of each course session to those students who have attended the course in its entirety.

UNIVERSITY DIPLOMA IN PREPARATION FOR ACADEMIC STUDIES

Entry requirements: French *baccalauréat* or equivalent from student's home country + C1 in French language. B2 is acceptable with admission based on student records and assessment test.

Study period: September 29, 2020 to June 5, 2021

Course duration: 2 semesters
Contact hours: 21 per week

✓ Assessment: continuous assessment and final exam

Course content:

Core courses:
 written and oral language skills / methodology for academic work
 / tutoring and support for the academic and professional project;

Science module:mathematics (algebra, probability, statistics...) / life science, chemistry;

Human and social sciences module: cultural, economic and social environment / institutional and historical context (French politics and history, global dynamics) / two electives to be chosen among the following: education as a "social fact", theology, political and legal institutions, art history, information and communication, sociology.

The BEC gives international students the opportunity to meet with French students, and spend time in a friendly atmosphere with French families wishing to share their way of life and culture.


It also organizes cultural events and sports activities:

REGISTRATION AND MODALITIES

REGISTRATION PROCESS

ON LINE

Registration on line: www.cidef.uco.fr

WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM AVAILABLE ON LINE

- 1 Fill in, sign and send the registration form (the form has to be signed by the parents if the student is under age).
- 2 Attach an "end of secondary studies certificate" or a document proving your registration in your home university.
- 3 Pay a 350€ deposit and the application fees per registered session. The deposit will be deducted from the tuition fees*.
- 4 Pay a 350€ deposit if you book accommodation through CIDEF. The deposit will be deducted from the accommodation fees.
- 5 Attach a photocopy of your passport. When we receive your documents, an official certificate or pre-registration will be sent.

Upon receipt of these documents, an official certificate of pre-registration will be sent.

CONDITIONS

- be 18 years old or be accompanied by an adult for the entire duration of the stay
- have a secondary study certificate
- arrival is possible at anytime during the program (except for beginners who must arrive at the beginning of each session)
- all courses started are due.

Cancellation fees

The registration fees and the deposits (350 € for tuition and 350€ for accommodation) are non-refundable in case of cancellation.

FORMALITIES

The administrative formalities necessary to enter France must be carried out by the student.

VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT

Registration to the OFII (French office of immigration and integration) is compulsory depending on your visa ((https://administration-etrangers-en-france.interieur.gouv.fr).

If you want to apply for a renewal of your visa, all tuition and registration fees should be paid before CIDEF can issue a registration certificate.

INSURANCE

Three types of insurance are needed:

- French public **health** insurance: Registration can be completed online upon arrival in France at etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr
- Third-party **insurance** (chargeable)
- Home insurance **policy** (chargeable)



- All bank charges are to be paid by students.
- -The balance should be paid by the end of the first week of the course.
