APPLIED MUSIC EMPHASIS (11-14 HOURS)

Students choose from among three applied skill areas:

VOCAL Required classes include: Vocal Diction 1 & 2, Instrumental Perspectives, Choral Conducting 1 & 2, Vocal Pedagogy,

(12 HOURS) Church Music Education 2, and Church Music Literature

INSTRUMENTAL Required classes include: Woodwind Methods 1 & 2, Brass Methods, String Methods, Percussion Methods,

(11 HOURS) Vocal Perspectives, Instrumental Conducting 1 & 2, and Instrumental Music Ministry

KEYBOARD
Required classes include: Ministry of the Keyboard Musician, Vocal Perspectives OR Instrumental Perspectives,
Choral Conducting 1 OR Instrumental Conducting 1, Piano Pedagogy OR Organ Pedagogy, Worship Service
Playing (piano or organ), Advanced Worship Service Playing (piano or organ), and Piano Seminar (piano principals only)
