

## 2021 Faulkner County Master Gardener (FCMG) Scholarship Instructions

**Description:** This scholarship assists a *Conway, Faulkner, or Perry County* resident in pursuing a degree in a plant science related field including agriculture, agricultural business, agricultural education, botany, forestry, horticulture, landscape architecture/design, plant science, and turf management **in an Arkansas college or university**. A scholarship will be awarded, and additional scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the scholarship committee. Over **\$63,000 in scholarships** has been awarded from 2004-2020. **Previous recipients may reapply.**

### **Instructions:**

1. Only completed applications **received by Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 will be reviewed.**
2. High school seniors must submit a copy of their high school transcript, ACT (or equivalent) scores, and a copy of all college transcript(s) if college courses are not listed on the high school transcript.
3. Undergraduate or graduate students must submit a copy of their collegiate transcript(s) showing all work completed from all higher education institutions. A copy of your current class schedule is required.
4. If mailing, postal employees determine required postage. No applications will be accepted past the due date.
5. If hand-delivering the application, all materials must be in a sealed envelope with your name and return address. The envelope must be addressed to: FCMG Scholarship Committee.
6. Applicants will receive notification of receipt of the applications.
