Students can have a record of volunteer hours on their university transcript through OuachitaServes! A permanent record of volunteer hours is helpful when applying for jobs and graduate schools!

OuachitaServes is also a great way to stay connected to needs in the community as weekly emails are sent to registered students with local options for service.

Service hours include any volunteer activity on campus or in the community for which the student is not paid. This also includes service at a church, missions, or in the classroom setting at Ouachita. Options for service through the Elrod Center can be found at obu.edu/elrod.

The process is simple!

- Register for OuachitaServes each semester at obu.edu/elrod/ouachitaserves.php.
- Volunteer a minimum of 20 hours each semester.
- Record volunteer hours on the hour verification form.
- Turn in hours to the Elrod Center at the end of the semester.
- Your semester transcript will reflect these hours.
