

List of Figures: Required (if you have one or more figures) List all the figures and non-text items and their page numbers used in your thesis. Figures must be numbered either sequentially Figure 1, Figure 2, etc. or sequentially by chapter Figure 1.1, Figure 1.2, Figure 2.1, Figure 3.1, etc. Figures captions listed here should be **exactly the same** as they appear in the text. (Include only the first sentence of each caption.)

Use the same university approved font and size as your body text. For **headings**, use a size not larger than 20-points. Don't double space, but add an extra line before the next title. Don't use bold, underline, or italics.

To set tabs: Click on the bottom right of the Paragraph tab and, in the Paragraph Settings window, click the Tabs button. Set the first tab to 0.75" (Align LEFT; Leader NONE); set a final indent to 6.0" (Align RIGHT; Leader DOTTED). Click Save.

Numbering starts over for figures in the appendices. Figure titles also include an "A" to indicate their placement in an appendix, e.g. Figure A1, Figure A2, etc.

Margins are 1" on the top, bottom, and right; 1.5" on the left. Page numbers should be Roman numerals and centered at the bottom at 0.5". You should use the appropriate Roman numeral for the page number according to its placement in your thesis.
