Biographical/Historical

Clark County was founded on 15 December 2018, as part of the Missouri Territory, one year prior to the creation of Arkansas Territory and eighteen years prior to Arkansas statehood. Clark included all or parts of at least fifteen counties in present-day Arkansas and parts of six counties in what is now Oklahoma. The county was named for Missouri Territorial Governor William Clark of the Lewis and Clark Expedition.
