Abstract: Includes correspondence, copies of vital records, Henry family genealogy, ephemera, newspaper clippings, educational, financial and military records, primarily pertaining to the family of Captain Ivan Richard Henry (USAF), his wife Martha Sue (Luster) Henry and their daughter, Suzanne. Correspondence from Henry to Martha Sue following his wounding in acting during the Korean Conflict is included, as well as over 350 photographs, including many of US Airmen who served with Henry during World War II and Korea.

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Biographical Summary

Ivan R. Henry was born 23 December 1919 in Vian, Oklahoma, to James P. and Ida Mae (Foster) Henry. The Henrys were a large family, with Ivan being the third oldest son in a family of about nine children. Ivan Henry graduated high school in Clinton, Oklahoma.

In 1939, Ivan joined the United States Air Force and remained in service for eleven years. As a cadet, he trained at Cimarron Field in Oklahoma. During World War II, Henry was stationed at bases in El Paso, Texas, Albany, Georgia, Memphis, Tennessee, and Blackpool, England. He graduated from the Blackland Arm Flying School in Waco, Texas, in January 1943. He served as an engineering officer and part-time pilot for the 57th Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron for three years. Serving in the European Theater of operations during World War II, Henry's plane was hit by flack over Cherbourg, France. He was able to return to England before bailing out of the damaged plane. Henry flew 41 missions during World War II as an F-51 pilot, for which he was awarded the Air Medal and six Oak Leaf Clusters.

On 7 December 1945, in Memphis, Tennessee, Henry married Martha Sue Luster. Martha was born 10 August 1921 in Batesville, Arkansas, to Champ Watson Luster and Georgia Ann Hazelrigg Luster. Martha graduated from Pine Bluff High School in 1939. On 2 March 1947, Ivan and Martha Sue welcome daughter, Suzanne.

In 1946, Henry completed U.S. Army Air Force Officers Staff School at Long Beach, California. Prior to his service in the Korean Conflict, Ivan was stationed at Hickam Air Force Base in Hawaii with the 5th Air Force. In 1951, Henry transferred from weather reconnaissance to fighter duties in Korea. Martha Sue and Suzanne returned from Hawaii to live with her parents, who now resided in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

Ivan's decision to transfer to fighter duties in Korea came after two of his brothers – Frederick and Christopher Columbus – were wounded in action. Lt. Frederick Henry was killed in action and posthumously received the Congressional Medal of Honor for outstanding military gallantry in action near Andong on 1 September 1950. Sfc. Christopher Columbus Henry lost one of his legs in Korea in 1951.

Between 21 November 1951 and 8 January 1952, Captain Ivan Henry participated in 20 missions. In early 1952, he was shot down over Korea and transferred to an Army Red Cross hospital in Tokyo to recover. For the twenty dive-bombing, rocketing, and strafing missions he flew between 1941-1952, he was awarded his seventh Oak Leaf Cluster.

Henry was discharged from the Air Force on 30 September 1959. He later worked as a meat inspector for the state of Arkansas.

By the 1980s, Ivan and Martha had divorced, although the date is not known. Ivan died in Arkadelphia on 1 May 2002. Martha Sue, now married to Clarence Dawson, died on 14 May 2001 in Springdale, Arkansas. In 1967, Suzanne married Dan Morel Riner (1943-2018). The couple had two sons, Dan Matthew (b. 1974) and Thomas (b. 1976), both of whom died in 2003. Suzanne Henry Riner died on 15 February 1997 and is buried in Rest Haven Memorial Garden in Arkadelphia.
