Biographical Summary

Henry William McMillan (1830-1910) was born in Robertson County, North Carolina, to John H. and Janet McNeil McMillan. He received his education at the University of North Carolina and moved to Arkansas in 1856 where he married Frances Toole Williams a year later. He worked as a schoolteacher and lawyer in Camden, Arkansas.

When the Civil War began, McMillan joined the Confederate Army and worked his way from first lieutenant to lieutenant colonel within the 12th Arkansas Infantry Regiment. After the war, McMillan moved his family to Arkadelphia, where he helped establish the law firm for Stewart, McCabe, and McMillan. He practice law until his death in 1910.
