Historical Summary

In the late 19th century, the sheet music business dominated the music industry in the United States. Parlor music took over the scene as the piano became a part of the middle-class home. This led to a demand for sheet music for home consumption. The genre that grew out of this demand was called Tin Pan Alley, from the area of New York City where most of the song publishers were located.

Success was measured by the sale of sheet music. To attract business, sheet music publishers hired artists to make beautiful covers. During this time, ragtime grew in popularity until 1918, when it was replaced by jazz. In the early 20th century the phonograph and recorded music grew in popularity and began to replace sheet music. In the 1920s, radio became the rage and eventually the record industry replaced the sheet music publishers as the prevailing music medium ([Courtesy of Gonzaga University Foley Library](#)).
