Policy on Time Limit for Completing Master's Degree

Proposed Change

Add a policy to the Graduate Catalog regarding the time limit for completing a master's degree.

Rationale

Requiring completion of a degree within an allotted timeframe ensures that graduates have received up-to-date training. There are some circumstances in which an extension is merited (e.g. military service), so the Graduate Council is able to approve extensions in such cases. The policy is also written so that individual programs may determine if they wish to provide a longer timeframe for completion of a degree.

Catalog Entry

Master's Time-to-Degree Limit

Unless otherwise specified for a particular program, all requirements for the master's degree must be completed within 5 years of initial enrollment in a graduate program at Ouachita Baptist University. Under extraordinary circumstances, students in good academic standing may petition the Graduate Council for an extension of the time limit to complete their degree.
