**Scholarship Purpose:** The purpose of the *Todd McCord Ministerial Scholarship* is to provide a Christian Ministries student with a \$500 per semester scholarship (not to exceed two semesters) for tuition.

**Scholarship Intent:** The scholarship's intent is to provide financial assistance for a Christian Ministries student who has a desire to combine a passion for evangelism and love for the outdoors as a means to reach people for Christ.

**Background:** Todd David McCord died of an acute asthma attack in November, 2009 at the age of 19. Todd began fishing bass tournaments at 11 years of age. His dream was to one day fish professionally and use his profession and love for the outdoors as a means of reaching people for Christ. This scholarship that bears his name is born out of that dream. Our desire, as his parents and his church, is to provide financial assistance to a Christian ministries student who desires to use his love for the outdoors to reach people for Christ.
