## Meet the Music Library Student Workers!





In this "Notes" issue, we are highlighting some new books that can be categorized loosely as literature on the psychological aspects of learning and playing music and auditioning. These titles include *Bounce: Mozart, Federer, Picasso, Beckham, and the Science of Success* by Matthew Syed; *Audition Success: An Olympic Sports Psychologist Teaches Performing Artists How to Win* by Don Greene; and *Ungifted: Intelligence Redefined* by Scott Kaufman. About *Ungifted*, Kirkus Reviews says, "An inspiring, informative affirmation of human potential." *Parade* calls it "A convincing – and moving – case for the great potential of even an 'ordinary' mind."

Also we have a controversial memoir by Blair Tindall, *Mozart in the Jungle: Sex, Drugs, and Classical Music*. The *Boston Herald* calls it "A scathing, eye-opening look at life in the orchestra pits."
