Maintain a minimum 2.700 cumulative GPA in all work
Minimum grade of C in Composition I, Mathematics for the Liberal Arts (or an approved course), and Foundations of Education
Minimum ACT Composite score of 24 (minimum score of 22 on the Math, Reading, and Writing sections) <u>or</u> minimum state scores on the Praxis Core Tests for Math, Reading, and Writing.
